## MARINA TECHNOLOGIES EXPANDS SOMMERSET POINTE YACHT CLUB & MARINA

Business partners Chris Roumayeh and Jonas Jerebko purchased Sommerset Point Yacht Club, located in Boyne City, Michigan, in 2018. Since then they have been busy improving and expanding the property, making it “the finest marina and destination on Lake Charlevoix, says Chris. “We have the best marina and the best restaurant on the Lake”, Chris continues. Continued demand for more wet slips drove the need to add more docks.

“The existing floating timber docks are 10 years old now and we’ll be lucky to get another 10 years out of them”, reports Chris. “Timber requires high maintenance and has a short useable lifespan, so when we decided to expand, we did some research on better systems. We wanted a dock system that was more durable, required less maintenance, and would last longer” explained Chris.

“We ended up purchasing new floating aluminum docks from Marina Technologies (MTI) – and we could not be happier with our decision, says Chris. The MTI team was a pleasure to work with, and the docks and matching gangway look beautiful. They went together with ease and we are now boasting that we have the best docks on Lake Charlevoix”!

The MTI docks have beautiful composite decking, PVC D-fender with full-length integrated backing plates, dual top-access utility troughs, adjustable cleats and finger piers, and silent - flexible connections. The docks are anchored with chain and concrete dead-men anchors.



The new expansion added 23 more slips – making our present total 105 slips. We plan to add more next year if the demand continues, says Chris. We are also expanding the uplands with new homes and plan to build a hotel in the near future”.
